

Short Moleben at Liturgy (славление)

After the “*Blessed be the name of the Lord*” (x3)

1. Troparion, Glory both Now and Ever, & Kontakion

2. Clergy & Choir sing refrains w/ Glory Both Now (2x) , then then Intercessory hymn:

(For Theotokos): O Most Holy Theotokos, Save us!

Save thy servants from harm, O Theotokos, / for all we, after God, flee unto thee, / as to an unassailable wall and intercessor. / Look with loving-kindness, / O all hymned -Theotokos, / upon my cruel bodily suffering, / and heal the sickness of my soul.

(For Christ and His Feasts): O Sweetest Jesus, save us!

Deliver Thy servants from harm, / O Thou Who art plenteous in mercy, / for we fervently flee unto Thee, / the merciful Redeemer, / Master of all, / O Lord Jesus.

(For Saints): O holy [Father, etc.]...pray to God for us!

Pray to God for us, O holy (N.), / for we fervently flee unto thee, / the speedy helper(s) and intercessor(s) for our souls.

3. Litany with Triple Lord have mercy

Deacon: Have mercy on us, O God, according to Thy great mercy, we pray Thee, hearken and have mercy.

Again we pray for our great lord and father, His Holiness Patriarch N., for our lord the Very Most Reverend Metropolitan N., for our lord the Most (Rt.) Reverend Bishop N. and for our all brethren in Christ.

Again we pray for American Land, its civil authorities and armed forces. all who in faith and piety dwell therein, and for every land, Let us pray to the Lord.

Again we pray for mercy, Life, peace, health, salvation, visitation, pardon, and prosperity for the servant(s) of God (N.). [or the brethren of this Holy temple.]

Again we pray that Thou will Strengthen our parish, turn back those that have gone astray, and forgive all our offenses voluntary and involuntary,. Grant us benefactors, workers, chanters, all things necessary for our common life, and bring us all to be of one heart and mind within Thy Holy Church. let us all say, O Lord, hearken and have mercy.

Again we pray that this town (or city) and this sacred temple, and every city and countryside, may be preserved from famine, pestilence, earthquake, flood, fire, the sword, the invasion of enemies, and civil discord; that our good and man loving God may be merciful and favorable, that He may turn away all the wrath stirred up against us, and deliver us from His righteous threatening which hangeth over us, and have mercy on us.

Again we pray also that the Lord God may hearken unto the voice of the supplication of us sinners, and have mercy on us.

Priest: Harken unto us, O God our Saviour, Thou hope of all the ends of the earth and of them that be far off at sea; and be merciful, be merciful, O Master, regarding our sins, and have mercy on us; for a merciful God art Thou, and the Lover of mankind, and unto Thee do we send up glory: to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever, and unto the ages of ages. **Choir:** Amen.

4. Prayer

Deacon: Let us pray to ...

Priest: *[reads a prayer appropriate to the purpose of the moleben].*

5. Magnification

Choir: Sings Magnification if there is one appointed.

Sermon (if not already given)

Priest: “The Blessing of the Lord be upon you.... “
